Backing tracks can be purchased and downloaded for a modest fee from various sources, as shown below. Or, you could source the original artiste's recording from amongst parents/grandparents and just have the children sing along to it, as many schools do. If you cannot source them from amongst the school community, then Amazon sell very cheap downloadable MP3 tracks for hundreds of thousands of songs. These can be purchased, downloaded on to a computer and then burnt on to a CD for performance. Below we give the song title and source of backing tracks. (SNOWFLAKES leave.)

WOMAN'S VOICE (Offstage)

Alice....oh Alice, come here Alice, come on....come and see....this beautiful land....its truly breath-taking

(ALICE wakes up and rubs her eyes.)

ALICE

That's strange. I was sure I heard a voice. I must have been dreaming. It's Christmas Eve!

WOMAN'S VOICE

You're not dreaming Alice.

ALICE

What? Who are you? And where are you?

WOMAN'S VOICE

I'm right here.

ALICE

Where?

WOMAN'S VOICE

Over here, just open your curtains and take a look.

ALICE

They must be outside my window. How very curious....well I suppose a quick look can't harm.

(ALICE goes to the curtains and opens them. As she does the curtains open fully (SEE PRODUCTION NOTES) to reveal a row of SNOWMEN, a row of PENGUINS behind them and, raised up, a row of SNOWFLAKES. At the side of the stage are REINDEERS and POLAR BEARS.)

ALICE

I don't understand. It's Christmas Eve, so I know it is winter, but there was no snow when I went to bed and....where are all the other houses....this doesn't look like my street at all.

SNOWMAN 1

'Do you wanna build a snowman?'

ALICE

What was that?

SNOWMAN 2

Come on let's go and play?

ALICE

Who said that?

(SNOWMAN 2 throws a snowball at ALICE.)

ALICE

Ouch, what was that?

SNOWMAN 3 (stepping forward)

That'll be Fluffy, ever the joker – he loves a snowball fight!

ALICE

You - you can talk!!

SNOWMAN 1

Hey Fluffy, that wasn't very friendly! We don't get many visitors round here so let's not scare them away!

ALICE

Oh no, it's happening again isn't it? I had a dream once full of talking rabbits and smiling cats! Now I'm dreaming about real live snowmen!

SNOW WOMAN 1 (annoyed)

Excuse me but I think you'll find that some of us are snow – women. What ever happened to political correctness??
