# THE FOURTH WISE MAN

SCENE 1.

(MUSIC)

# **NARRATOR**

Long, long ago – over two thousand years ago, in fact – the people of a small village in China prayed to their gods to send them rain. It had not rained for many years and the villagers were desperate. Every year they performed a dance for their gods, in the hope that the rain would come.

(The villagers stand and watch while some of the girls perform a simple dance with fans. The dance finishes and everyone looks up at the sky.)

# 1<sup>st</sup> VILLAGER

It hasn't worked. The spirits are still angry with us.

2<sup>nd</sup> VILLAGER

It's never going to rain. What shall we do?

3<sup>rd</sup> VILLAGER

We must ask Li Chan. He is the wisest man in the village. He will help us.

# No.1 DAUGHTER

My father is very old and tired. You mustn't bother him now.

#### 1<sup>st</sup> VILLAGER

But he is the only one who can help us. We must see him.

(Li Chan appears. He is walking slowly and is supported by No.2

Daughter. She is also carrying a basket with three flowers in it.)

#### LI CHAN

What is it that you want from me?

#### **NO.3.DAUGHTER**

Father, the people from the village want to ask your advice.

#### LI CHAN

What advice can an old man like me give them?

# 2<sup>nd</sup> VILLAGER

Can you tell us why the rain has not come?

# 3<sup>rd</sup> VILLAGER

Yes, Li Chan. For many years now, we have been without rain. The land is dying. The rivers are drying up.

# 1<sup>st</sup> VILLAGER

We have danced and sung for the spirits and they do not help us. What shall we do?

# LI CHAN

Foolish woman. Do you think that I know the answer?

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> VILLAGER

You are the wisest man we know. You read the signs in the sky. What do the stars tell you is going to happen?

3<sup>rd</sup> VILLAGER

Yes. Do they tell you that it is going to rain?

LI CHAN

No. The stars say nothing about rain.

(All the villagers groan with disappointment)

#### LI CHAN

But the stars – one star in particular – tells me that something extraordinary is about to happen.

**ALL VILLAGERS** 

What? What is going to happen? Tell us!

LI CHAN

Do you see that very big and bright star up there?

(He points upwards and they all look)

**VILLAGERS** 

Yes! Yes!

**NO.3 DAUGHTER** 

What does it mean, father?

#### LI CHAN

It means that a great lord will be born very soon. A king, a mighty prince, a great leader – and that he will be the answer to everyone's prayers.

1<sup>ST</sup> VILLAGER

You mean that the king will make it rain?

LI CHAN

He might. The star only tells me that this great birth will happen.

Anything more than that I do not know.

2<sup>ND</sup> VILLAGER

When will this king be born?

LI CHAN

In a few month's time. That much I know.

**NO.2.DAUGHTER** 

Where will he be born? In China?

LI CHAN

No. I do not think so. To find the king, you must follow the star. It will lead you to his birthplace.

3<sup>RD</sup> VILLAGER

Li Chan, you must go and find this king. You must take him gifts and pray to him to bring the rain.

LI CHAN

No, I cannot go. I am too old to make such a journey.
